Individual Client Level Data – ICLD

What information is MSD/Oranga Tamariki asking you to share?

Client demographic data

- Name
- Date of birth
- Address
- Gender
- Ethnicity
- Iwi
- Country of birth

Dependents

- Number of dependents
- Date of birth of youngest dependent

Service detail

- Programme/ service name
- Start date and end date
- Source of referral

ICLD raises concerns for citizens, service users, providers, professional bodies, other stakeholders



IMPLICATIONS

NGOs are being asked to hand over people's personal information in return for government funding.

A contract requirement.

Or in other words . . .

No Data, No Funding

Will gathering administrative data on individuals improve services?

The connection is not apparent.

Governments and service providers need information.
But we cannot ignore issues of . . .

- Privacy
- Purpose
- Risk
- Ethics

And the critical issue
of informed consent

Good decision by Government not to proceed immediately. We still have big challenges ahead.

Same issues need to be worked through: reason for data collection, privacy, ethics, security protocols, compliance costs

NGOs will have direct input to the next stage of work being led by the Social Investment Agency to develop a social sector data system. Will also involve Privacy Commissioner, Statistics NZ and MSD.
